HOW CAN YOU HELP PREVENT CAVITIES IN YOUR CHILD'S BABY TEETH?



The Sioux Lookout Zone Dental Program has partnered with the University of Toronto in a research project to determine whether fluoride varnish applied to the teeth can significantly reduce cavities in babies and preschool age children.

Fluoride varnish is a protective coating that makes the outer surface of the teeth stronger.

The study requires 6 treatments of the varnish to your child's teeth over 18 months, and there is no cost for these treatments.
